

「松浦党」はじまりの地 今福神社

The Location Where the Matsuura Party Began

Imafuku Shrine



応徳元年(西暦1084年)、江州多賀社(現在の滋賀県にある多賀大社)より、イザナギノミコト・イザナミノミコトのお神霊を勧請して創建。嵯峨天皇の血を引く「源久(松浦党党祖)」ゆかりの地である。松浦党とは、源平天下分け目となった「壇ノ浦の合戦」において平家水軍として活躍し、鎌倉時代の蒙古襲来(元寇:文永の役/1274年、弘安の役/1281年)において、勇戦を尽くした“海の武士団”を指す。

この地を治めるために久公が『ぎぎが浜(松浦市今福)』に上陸後、この宮で年を越したことから『歳の宮』とも呼ばれている。明治時代になり、現在の『今福神社』に改称した。

Imafuku Shrine was founded in 1084 for welcoming the divine spirit of Izanagi no Mikoto and Izanami no Mikoto from the Goshu Taga Shrine (currently named “Taga-Taisha Grand Shrine” in Shiga Prefecture). It is also the place associated with Minamoto no Hisashi, founder of the Matsuura Party and a decedent of Emperor Saga. The Matsuura Party played an active role in the Navy of the Taira Clan at the decisive battle of the Genpei War, the Battle of Dannoura. The Matsuura Party is also referred to as the “brave warriors of the sea” in the Mongol Invasions of Japan (the Battle of Bunai in 1274 and the Battle of Koan in 1281).

Imafuku Shrine is also known as the “Toshi no Miya (Year Shrine)” because Hisashi spent the new year here after landing at Gigigahama Beach (Imafuku, Matsuura City) to govern this region. In the Meiji Period, the name was changed to the current “Imafuku Shrine.”
